Friday, September 13

The museum, part of the Smithsonian Institutions' National Air and Space Museum is dedicated to the preservation and display of its collection of historic aviation and space artifacts. Located at Washington International Dulles Airport, the facility has large aviation and space exhibit hangars. The museum currently has over eighty aircraft and dozens of space artifacts on display including the Space Shuttle Discovery, an SR71 Blackbird, the Dash 80 prototype of the Boeing 707, and the B-29 Superfortress "Enola Gay." Lunch options include a food-court style McDonald's and coffee place (lunch on your own). You may tour the exhibits at your own pace, there is a lot of walking so please wear comfortable shoes.

Bus cost is \$765.00 for 55 passengers which will be approximately \$14.00 per passenger with full bus. Please note less passengers the cost will be somewhat more. If second bus required, the rate will be double so its most important to register early for rates to be calculated.

CITY TOUR/VIETNAM WALL MEMORIAL Saturday, September 14,

See the sites of our nation's capital during a narrated driving tour of Washington, D.C. Ride by the Jefferson Memorial, the Mall, Capitol Building, Washington Monument, White House, and other notable monuments and federal buildings. Stop at the Ronald Reagan Building and International Trade Center, which is the largest building (3.1 million square feet) in Washington DC and is the first and only federal building dedicated to both government and private use. While there, enjoy lunch on your own at the Reagan Building food court - named one of the "best family food courts" in DC. This afternoon stop at the National World War II Memorial, the first national memorial dedicated to all who served during World War II. The day wraps up with a stop at a central location between the Lincoln Memorial and Korean War Memorial for a brief visit or more time at the Wall. The Vietnam Veterans' Memorial stands a symbol of America's honor and recognition of the mem and women who served and sacrificed their lives in the Vietnam War. A photo ID is required to entrance to the Ronald Reagan Building.

Bus -Luxury Coach

Bus cost is \$1,059.00 for 55 passengers which will be approximately \$20.00 per passenger with full bus. Note: additional cost is for tour guide. Also note less passengers the cost will be somewhat more. Tour guides can be difficult to arrange so a second bus could be problematic. Important that you make your request known "EARLY" in order to accommodate you.

Working on a Plan B!

My wife Paula has contacts at both the white House and Congress. In lieu of the city tour, she is working on getting us a tour of the White House. The earliest we can confirm, however is 90 days out. Her contact feels reasonably sure of getting us the tour but no promises! Furthermore, Paula's Congress contact said it should be no problem getting the Congress tour (the chamber you watch on TV). This changes our original itinerary. The White House and Congress tours are better for Friday, therefore a shift of the Udvar- Hazy Smithsonian Aviation Museum tour will be shifted to Saturday. In this case the guided tour will be dropped which will be a reduced bus charge as well.

Lunch (Cafeteria style) at Reagan Building

Depart Reagan Building 1330

Bus stops at Vietnam Memorial near both Lincoln and Korean War Memorials.

Bus departs memorials at 1440 enroute to Sheraton.

Depart Sheraton at 0900 enroute to Udvar-Hazy Center Tour Udvar Hazy at leisure. Lunch on your own at McDonald's inside museum. Depart Udvar Hazy at 1410 enroute to Sheraton with short stop at Marine Corps memorial
